Property Tax Rebate (PTR1 & PTR2)

The Senior Freeze Program reimburses eligible senior citizens and disabled persons for property tax or mobile home park site fee increases on their principal residence (mail home). You must be 65 or older, or received social security disability as of 12/31/2022. The deadline for 2023 application is 10/31/2024. Income for 2022 is \$150,000 and for 2023 is \$163,050. We can assist you in completing the application.
